Every employee and contractor will have to take responsibility for their own health & safety, and that of their colleagues, and feel empowered to challenge any work process if they believe it to be unsafe or unhealthy.
- Engagement and empowerment are key to Health and Safety. As an essential part of this, we will provide information, instruction and training to enable employees to perform their work safely. Additionally, we will consult with our workforce and encourage their participation in Health & Safety matters.


